3 Regulations

3.1 Rules/Regulations

The 23rd Luxembourg Euro Meet 2021 will be held under the rules of FINA and the Luxembourg Swimming Federation (FLNS). Every swimmer who is member of a team, club or national federation, registered with FINA, may participate.

3.2 Pool

Both competition pools, at the Coque and Campus Geesseknäppchen, are 50m pools with 10 lanes, depth is 2,20m throughout and the water temperature is 26°C. Time keeping is operated by electronic Swiss timing.

Throughout the meeting at

- the Coque a six lane 50m training pool and a 25m warm-up pool are available
- Campus Geesseknäppchen a 25m warm up pool is available.

3.3 Age categories entries

The age categories of the Euro Meet 2021 are the following:

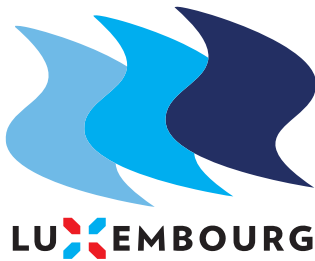

- b) 1500m Freestyle
Direct final with maximum 30 swimmers (3 heats) selected based on the 20 fastest overall entry times, next 5 fastest entry times Junior and next 5 fastest entry times Youth
- c) 400m Freestyle / Medley
Maximum 60 swimmers (6 heats) selected based on the 50 fastest overall entry times, next 5 fastest entry times Junior and next 5 fastest entry times Youth

Direct finals for all age categories	Events 1, 2, 5, 6, 23, 24
A-finals only for the 10 fastest swimmers of the heats, regardless of age category	Events 25, 26
A- and B-finals for the fastest 20 swimmers of the heats, regardless of age category	all other events

The entry times shall be 50m pool times and not older than January 1st, 2019. The OC will verify the indicated entry time and reserves the right to reject entries with older or non-verifiable times.

Each entry NOT accompanied by an official written confirmation, stating where and when the time has been realised, will be rejected.

To guarantee a fluid competition, a maximum of 3.000 entries will be accepted. The OC reserves the right to exclude entries after closing of registration.

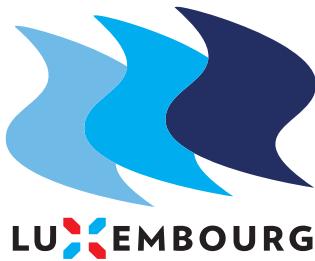
The organizer reserves the right to allocate several starts to swimmers affiliated to the FLNS, regardless of entry time.

3.5 Classification

3.5.1 Individual and relay classification

Classification in the age categories "Youth" and "Junior" will be made according to the results in the heats/direct finals.

Classification in the "Open" category will be made according to the results in the A-finals/direct finals.

3.5.2 Team classification

The team classification will be made according to the best thirty (30) individual results (as per actual FINA points-table) for each team realised during the heats only. For teams having less than 30 starts all results will be considered.

The team classification prize ceremony will take place on Sunday afternoon before the start of the afternoon session. The teams ranked 1st till 3rd must send their head coach only to participate in this ceremony.

3.6 Event schedule

3.6.1 Warm-up

Warm-up and training in the competition pools are possible from Friday to Sunday until 15 minutes before the start of each session.

For details, please check the website for the preliminary competition schedule.

3.6.2 Preliminary Competition Schedule

Heats will be divided into groups of slower and faster heats.

- slower heats will be held at Campus Geesseknäppchen
- faster heats at Coque

Finals will be divided in A- and B-Finals.

All finals will be swum at the Coque.

The afternoon session will start with all B-Finals. A-Finals will follow.

3.6.3 Program

In principle the competition will take place according to the preliminary schedule published on the website. The starting times of the sessions may be changed depending on the number of entries. A detailed preliminary schedule of the competition will be published on the official website approximately one (1) week before the start of the event and distributed in the welcome bags upon arrival.

3.7 Prizes

Overall, the Luxembourg Euro Meet offers € 21.800,- of prize money.

In the age category "Open" prize money will be paid in all events to the first three winners of the A-Finals and Direct Finals.

Individual events

- 1st : € 300,-
- 2nd : € 200,-
- 3rd : € 100,-

Team classification

- 1st : € 800,-
- 2nd : € 400,-
- 3rd : € 200,-

Records

- World Record (Open) € 3.000,-
- European Record (Open) € 2.000,-
- Meet Record € 300,-
- Junior World Record € 500,-
- Junior European Record € 500,-

Prize money for all records is not cumulative and is paid for the best performance once per event per athlete.

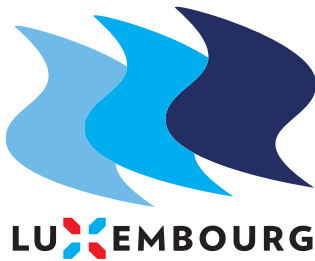
In the age groups "Junior" and "Youth", medals will be awarded to the first three swimmers of each event. To be awarded the prizes and medals, the time standards fixed by the OC must be reached and the swimmer has to attend the victory ceremony.

Depending on the sanitary regulations due to COVID-19, medal ceremony for "Junior" and "Youth" might be cancelled.

3.8 Entry fees

The entry fees are as follows:

- One-time entry fee per team, club or national federation: € 20,-
- Covid compensation per Individual (Athlete and Staff) including a personal mask: €15,-
- Entry fee for an individual event: € 15,-
- Bank charges on behalf of the team, club or federation

Following quota for team accreditations for coaches, physios, team staff will be applied:

- 2 for up to 6 competitors
- 3 for up to 10 competitors
- 4 for up to 15 competitors
- 5 for more than 20 competitors

3.9 Withdrawals before event

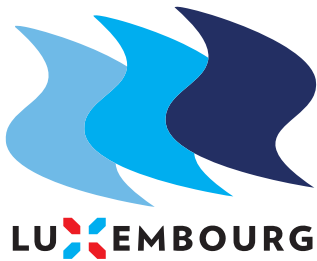
Upon entry deadline, January 8th, entry lists will be established as soon as possible. In relation with events 1, 2, 5, 6, 23, 24, 25 and 26 the entry-lists will include 10 reserve swimmers.

- 6 Open category swimmers
- 2 Junior category swimmers
- 2 Youth category swimmers

As soon as a withdrawal has been received prior to the Team Leaders Meeting on January 28th, 2021, the respective entry lists will be updated and reserve swimmers will be assigned.

Following the Team Leaders Meeting, start lists for events 1, 2, 5 and 6 will be established as soon as possible and distributed as printed versions as well as on the official Euro Meet website.

Withdrawals for events 23 and 24 can be made until Friday, January 29th, 2021 before the end of the afternoon session. Start lists for these two events will then be made available on Saturday morning.

Withdrawals for events 25 and 26 can be made until Saturday, January 30th, 2021 before the end of the slower heats during the morning session. Start lists for these two events will then be made available as soon as possible.

3.10 Registration deadline

4 Event Guide

4.1 Accommodation

The Euro Meet has 4 official hotels which offer special rates for the teams participating in the competition. Special rates will be applied when using booking forms available on the official website www.euromeet.lu and are only guaranteed until December 31st 2020. Other, more expensive rates may apply after that deadline.

For the official hotels, which are not within walking distance to the pool, a shuttle service will be available for the teams to bring them from the hotel to the pool and back to the hotel. Please check the published schedule.

Depending on travel restrictions in each country, the FLNS, if timely notified, can take care of reservation at hotels in France, Belgium and Germany, right next to the Luxembourg border. Transport from these hotels to the venue must be organised by the participant though.

4.1.1 Novotel Luxembourg-Kirchberg

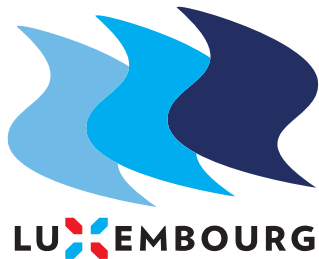

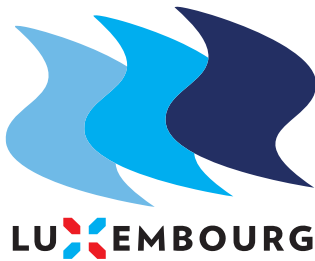
4.2.1.1 Arrival by Plane

4.2.1.3 Arrival by car/bus

4.2.2 Departure

Departure times of the teams/federations travelling by train or plane must be indicated at arrival by the head of delegation in order to organize transport in time to the airport or the train station. Please indicate your departure time and date while doing the online registration and confirm this information latest at your arrival. In case of any changes in your travel schedule please inform the responsible persons at the welcome desk immediately.

4.3 Event Shuttle

Teams which have not booked their hotel through the OC are responsible for their own transport.

Teams which have reserved a hotel near the border of Luxembourg are responsible for their own transport.

A shuttle service will be running between the pools and the hotels Melia, Novotel, IBIS and IBIS Budget.

The detailed schedule for the shuttle bus will be distributed with the welcome bag and published in the entrance of the pools and in the hotel lobbies.

Public transport in Luxembourg is entirely free of charge and stops are close to both venues. For details, please refer to our team.

4.5 Training

Training in the 6x50m training pool at the Coque is possible as follows:

- Wednesday from 18h00 – 21h00, **only with in-advance reservation** through the OC
- Thursday from 08h00 until 20h00, **only with in-advance reservation** through the OC
- Friday to Sunday from 08h00 until 30 minutes after the end of the competition
- Monday from 08h00 – 12h00, **only with in-advance reservation** through the OC

Training at Campus Geesseknappchen is possible:

- Thursday 12h00 – 21h00, **only with in-advance reservation** through the OC

Training in the competition pools outside warm-up times is **not** possible.

5 Team Guide

5.1 Welcome Desk

5.2 Accreditation

5.2.1 Team accreditations

Team accreditations in 2021 consist of a personalized protective mask. The mask can only be picked up if the participant has submitted the PARTICIPANT CONSENT FORM in advance, together with the team registration. The mask must be worn at any time inside the pools. Participants not wearing their personalized mask will not be granted access to the pool deck. In case an accreditation gets lost, the team representative may apply for a new one at the Welcome Desk.

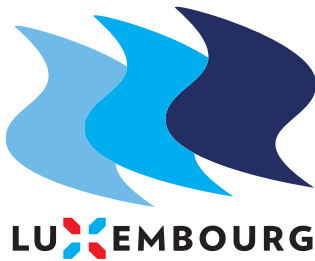
For renewal of a lost accreditation, the OC will charge € 15,- to be paid directly in cash or with credit card.

5.2.2 Access control

All access doors and zones of the Aquatic centres will be guarded by security personnel. Access to the different zones will only be granted with personalized masks. For the access to the shuttle bus the mask will also be required.

5.3 Team Leaders Meeting

The Technical Meeting for all Team Leaders will be held on Thursday, January 28th, 2021 at 17h00 in the Amphitheatre within the Coque.

5.4 Jury

The Jury will consist of qualified judges from the Fédération Luxembourgeoise de Natation et de Sauvetage (FLNS). The referees and starters are listed on the actual FINA-Lists.

If a team/club or federation wishes to bring an official to support the jury, please contact the OC through email and provide the following information:

- qualification
- availability throughout the weekend
- possible positions
- language skills (English, French or German required)
- T-Shirt-size (an event-shirt may be provided)

At the registration deadline on January 8th, 2021 the team/club will be informed if the official will be part of the jury.

Please note that all expenses are up to the team/club or federation bringing the official along to the Luxembourg Euro Meet 2021.

5.5 Officials meeting

Officials meetings will be held one hour before the start of each session in the official's room.

5.6 Competition Office

The competition office is located on the pool level next to the diving platforms and the starting centre. The competition office is accessible to team leader's for withdrawals, protests and technical information.

The Competition office at Geesseknaepchen is located at the starting end of the pool.

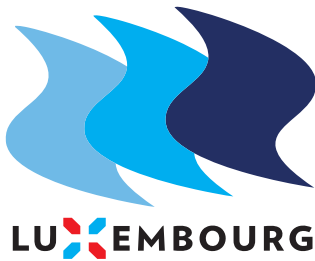
5.7 Withdrawals

Withdrawals from A- and B-Finals must be declared in writing to the competition office not later than 30 minutes after the display of the results of the respective event. Late withdrawals or a no show will be fined in accordance with FINA rules.

5.8 Call room

The call room at the Coque is located behind the diving pool (except for the 50m races, where it will be at the turn end).

The call room at Geesseknaepchen is located behind the starting end of the pool for all events.

Athletes are fully responsible to be on time in the call room. Please always check the actual race program while the competition is running.

5.9 Victory Ceremony

Victory ceremonies for the A-Finals will take place immediately after the finals. The three first athletes of every A-Final are reminded not to leave the mixed zone until the victory ceremony is finished.

Victory ceremonies for the age groups will take place before the B-Finals in the afternoon. Athletes participating at the victory ceremonies are requested to come immediately to the podium after having been requested to do so by the announcer. Presence at the respective ceremonies is mandatory. Prizes will not be handed out if a swimmer misses his/her ceremony.

Depending on sanitary restrictions, victory ceremonies might be modified or cancelled, also on short notice.

5.10 Results

In the Aquatic centers a free wireless internet access will be available and results may be downloaded from the official website immediately after the end of the race.

The results will also be published at different points in the pools. Live-timing will be available on the website.

5.11 Locker rooms

Locker rooms are located next to the entrance to the Aquatic center. Keys for lockers are available at the main desk of the Coque with a deposit of € 15,-.

Lockers are available at Campus Geesseknäppchen for € 2,-.

6.1 Press accreditation

Media accreditations (Journalists, Photographers and Camera-teams) must be ordered at least one week in advance via the official form, available from the website under Organization – Downloads and sent by e-mail to the following address: euromeet@flns.lu.

Accreditations in 2021 consist of a protective mask. The mask can only be picked up if the MEDIA CONSENT FORM has been sent together with the registration. The mask must be worn at any time inside the Aquatic Center. No access will be granted without the event mask. In case an accreditation gets lost, the team representative may apply for a new one at the Welcome Desk.

The masks will be issued at the Welcome Desk at the Coque.

The welcome desk at the pool is open as follows:

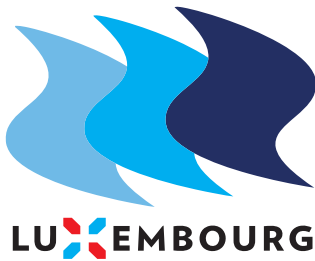
