1 Introduction and Event Key Dates

The CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet is organised by the Luxembourg Swimming Federation:
The 25th edition of the CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet 2025 has been requested to World Aquatics to be classified as a qualifying event for the World Aquatics Championships in Singapore.

2 Rules & Regulations

2.1 Rules

The CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet 2025 will be held under the rules of World Aquatics (AQUA) and the Luxembourg Swimming Federation. Every swimmer who is member of a team, club or national federation, registered with AQUA, may participate.

2.2 Pool

CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet 2025 takes place at the Aquatic Centre of d'Coque.

Address of the d'Coque is 2, rue Léon Hengen, L-1745 Luxembourg (www.coque.lu).

The venue has a 50m competition pool with 10 lanes and with a depth of 2.2m, a 50m training pool with 6 lanes and a 25m warm-up pool with 4 lanes.

Time keeping is operated by electronic SWISS timing and backstroke ledges are available.

CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet 2025 is staged over 3 days with preliminary heats in the morning sessions. Fastest heats in long distance events and A & B Finals are scheduled in the afternoon sessions. All events are swum in 10 lanes. The following entry restrictions apply:

- 800m Freestyle
Direct final with maximum 40 swimmers (4 heats) selected based on the 30 fastest overall entry times, next 5 fastest entry times Junior and next 5 fastest entry times Youth.
- 1500m Freestyle
Direct final with maximum 30 swimmers (3 heats) selected based on the 20 fastest overall entry times, next 5 fastest entry times Junior and next 5 fastest entry times Youth.
- 400m Freestyle / 400m Individual Medley
Maximum 60 swimmers (6 heats) selected based on the 50 fastest overall entry times, next 5 fastest entry times Junior and next 5 fastest entry times Youth.

The entry times must be 50m pool times and must not be older than 1st January 2023. Each entry must be accompanied by an official written confirmation stating the place and date of the entry time or will be rejected otherwise.

To guarantee a fluid competition, a maximum of 3,000 entries are accepted.

The organiser reserves the right to:

- reject entries after the registration deadline to manage the session times.
- allocate starts to swimmers affiliated to FLNS, regardless of entry time.

2.5 Heat sessions (Sessions 1, 3 and 5)

The organiser reserves the right to divide Sessions 1, 3 and 5 into groups of slower and faster heats. In this case, the morning heat sessions start with the group of faster heats followed by the slower heats respectively the direct finals. The starting times of the heat sessions depend on the number of entries.

2.6 Final sessions (Sessions 2, 4 and 6)

The afternoon final sessions 2, 4 and 6 start with all B finals followed by the A finals. The starting times of the Final sessions are communicated before the start of the competition.

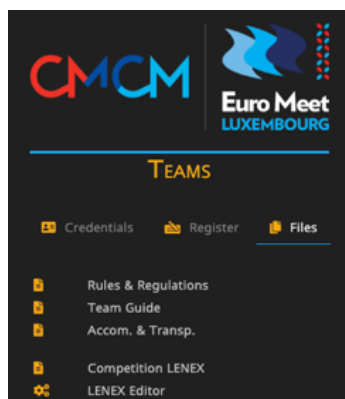

There is no refund for absent swimmers. No substitutions or additions are accepted after the entry deadline.

2.9 Registration deadline



The registration for the 25th CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet opens on 1st November 2024 and can only be done online via the registration application: <http://app.euromeet.lu/>. For a detailed description on how to register, please refer to the 'Team Guide' available on the Euro Meet APP.

Registration closes on Friday 17th January 2025 at midnight.

2.10 Withdrawals for heats

Upon entry deadline, 17th January 2025, entry lists are established as soon as possible and published on the website www.euromeet.lu.

The entry lists for events 1, 2, 5, 6, 23, 24, 25 and 26 include 10 reserve swimmers:

- 6 Open swimmers
- 2 Junior swimmers
- 2 Youth swimmers

As soon as withdrawals are received, the respective entry lists will be updated.

2.11 Withdrawals for finals

Withdrawals from A and B Finals including the reserves must be done via the APP [http://app.euromeet.lu/](http://app.euromeet.lu) not later than 30 minutes after the display of the results of the respective event. Late withdrawals and 'No Shows' are fined.

2.12 Classification

Individual classification

Classification in the age categories Youth and Junior is based on the results of the heats/direct finals. Classification in the Open category is based on the results of the A-finals/direct finals.

Team classification

The team classification ranking is based on sum of the top 30 individual results (AQUA points) realised during the heats.

2.13 Prize money

CMCM Luxembourg Euro Meet 2025 offers € 35,400 of prize money. Prize money for a record is not cumulative and is paid for the most valuable record once per event.

In the category Open, prize money is paid in all events to the first 3 swimmers of the A finals and direct finals. In the age groups Junior and Youth, medals are awarded to the first 3 swimmers in each event based on the results achieved in the heats or direct finals if the time standards are reached.

2.14 Victory ceremonies

Victory ceremonies for the A finals take place as indicated in the programme.

The time schedule of the victory ceremonies of the age groups is communicated in due time. Swimmers must attend the victory ceremonies to obtain their medals & prizes

3 Miscellaneous

3.1 Accreditation

Team accreditations are issued to the Team Manager at the Welcome Desk. Accreditations must be picked up before entering the Aquatic Centre and must be always worn. Athletes and coaches are not granted access to the Aquatic Centre without accreditation.

The number of staff accreditation per team, club or national federation is allocated as follows:

3.2 Access control

All access doors and zones of the Aquatic Centre are guarded by security personnel. Access to the different zones and shuttle buses is only granted with an accreditation.

3.3 Resolution Desk

The Resolution Desk is located next to the diving platform and the Call Room. Team leaders should contact the Resolution Desk for technical information or protests.

3.4 Call Room

The Call Room is located behind the diving pool. The Call Room for the 50m events is at the turn end of the pool. Athletes are responsible to arrive on time to the Call Room.

3.5 Results

There is free wireless internet access in the Aquatic Centre. Live-timing and results will be available on the official website.

3.6 Media

Euro Meet is covered by photographers and video cameras. By registering, you allow FLNS and their partners to cover the event and to publish material on their website, social media and media networks.

3.7 Liability

FLNS declines all liabilities for theft, accidents or damage of any kind.

3.8 Safeguarding and integrity

FLNS is actively engaged, for the benefit of athletes, coaches, officials, referees and other participants in its activities, in the protection of their health, the promotion of their well-being and the fight against all forms of abuse and physical, mental, psychological, sexual or other violence.
